Record number of participants sparks excitement for future 8K events

A beautiful summer night at the 12th-century castle Muiderslot in Muiden, The Netherlands, set the stage for an energetic crowd of participants at the fifth annual Pink Moon Run & Walk. Chaperoned by safety team captain Antoinette van Bruggen and the SwaboLadies cycling team, who is promoting A Sister's Hope this year and sporting the logo on their competition uniforms, 143 walkers and runners covered the course that night and raised more than 7,500 euro for breast cancer research to save lives.

Sincere thanks to Roeland van der Mijn, director and "keeper of the castle", for once again being a tremendous host and so very flexible and responsive in the planning of this event. He and his staff help make Pink Moon a fun event from start to finish.

Top fundraiser was Monique van den Hoek, a regular 60K Walker who will miss this year's October event due to travel, and she decided to put her efforts toward the 2013 Pink Moon. Top youth fundraiser was Dionne Spaltman who walks each July and has been raising money for A Sister's Hope since 2007.

Charity breast cancer events: which to choose? A Sister's Hope is top choice

When your main charitable objective is funding breast cancer researchers who are looking for more effective treatments, your best choice for organizations to join is A Sister's Hope. secure funding for their projects because available funds have been allocated to large, multi-year projects, and the money sits in an account waiting to be used while the loved ones of many die from breast cancer. This is unacceptable and must change.

If a researcher needs 2.5 million euro for a 4-year project, she can start with 750,000 euro the first year and ask for more funding the next year. Meanwhile, other brilliant researchers can share the other 1,750,000 euro to move their ideas forward. We must adjust and do things in a way that recognizes TIME IS CRITICAL. When the life of your partner, your mother, your daughter or yourself is the one who could be saved by moving things along more quickly, wouldn't you agree?
