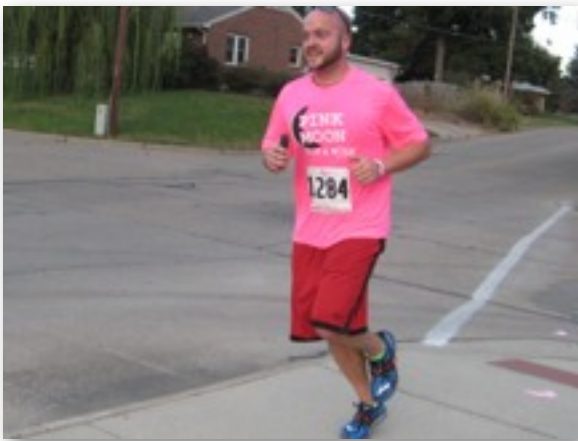
Missouri event dates set for 2016

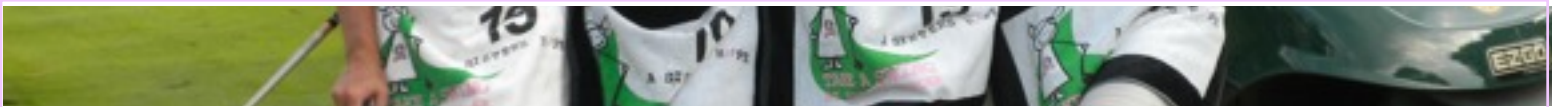
Although winter is still hanging on across much of the United States, it is time to think about golfing, walking and running to give a sister hope.
